**CBP Officers:** CBP personnel at ports of entry have a unique opportunity to notify and encourage LPRs who may be eligible to naturalize.

**Kiosks:** Automated Passport Control (APC) kiosks can provide pop-up notifications informing LPRs about their potential eligibility to apply for U.S. citizenship.
